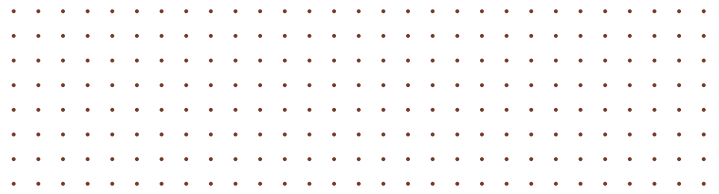

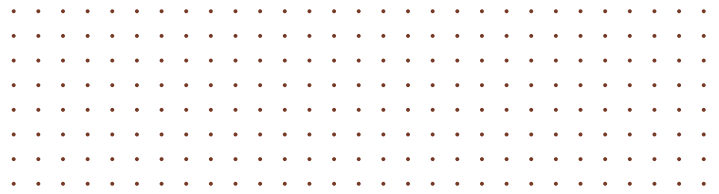

Micro-learning for the Construction Safety Orientation Course – WSH Council

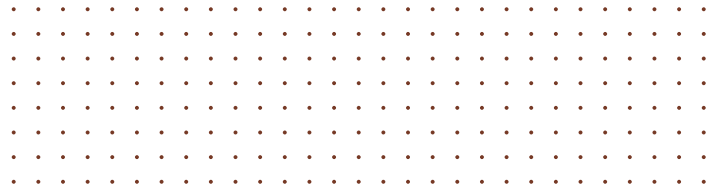
The Ministry of Manpower and WSH Council will enable continuous WSH learning among workers, starting with construction, through a new online micro-learning component to the Construction Safety Orientation course (CSOC). The micro-learning modules will refresh workers' WSH knowledge on conducting high-risk work activities safely, such as work at height, and working around vehicles and machinery. The micro-learning will also offer learnings from recent cases to better prevent accidents.

It is delivered online in bite-sized modules in workers' native languages, so workers can access the learning at their convenience, without having to go to a physical training centre. From January 2024, the CSOC recertification assessment will include questions from the micro-learning topics. Workers that fail the recertification assessment will be required to complete the CSOC and micro-learning before trying the recertification again.

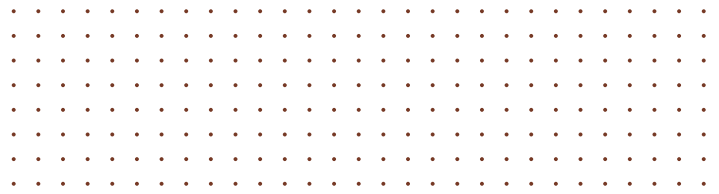

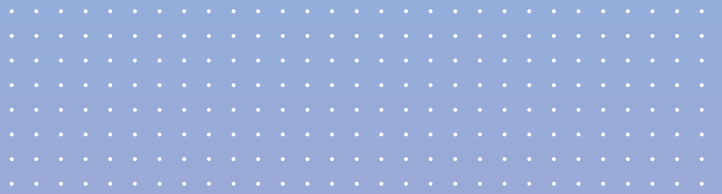

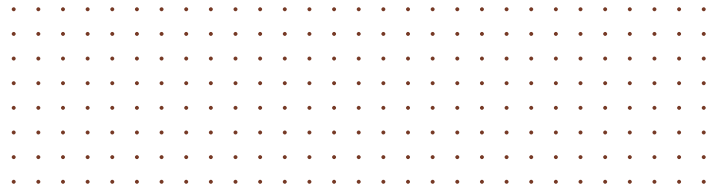

EA SAFETY COMMITTEE MEMBERS MEETING

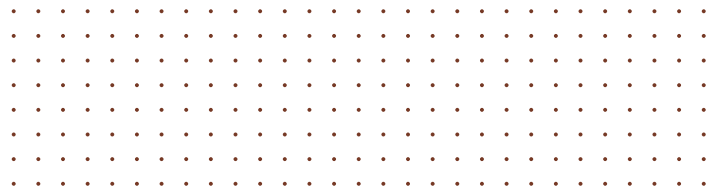

SkillsFuture Festival Opens this July with More Events and with a Focus on Digital Upskilling for Business and Career Growth

Minister for Education, Mr Chan Chun Sing, launched the SkillsFuture Festival 2023 on 4th July 2023 at the SkillsFuture Forum held at the Lifelong Learning Institute. The Festival will be open to the community from 4 July to 18 August.

DIGITAL SKILLS

The SkillsFuture Forum adopted the theme of “Digital Upskilling for Business and Career Growth”. SSG and Generation Singapore co-issued a SkillsFuture Job-Skills Insights publication to highlight mid-career transition possibilities into the Digital Economy.

A series of masterclasses, called the “Superpower Me Series”, will introduce individuals and enterprises to the use of ChatGPT as a tool to improve personal and workplace productivity. This emphasis reflects SSG’s broader focus on preparing our workforce and society, to make full use of increasingly powerful (and widely available) software.

As announced by Minister Chan at the SkillsFuture Forum, SSG will relaunch the SkillsFuture for Digital Workplace (SFDW).

SFDW 2.0 includes refreshed digital content, focusing on four key areas – automation, cybersecurity risk, data analytics and in-demand digital tools – to help Singaporeans better prepare for the digital economy.

EMPOWERING THE SMES

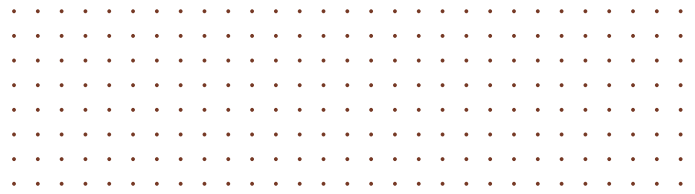
At the Forum, Minister Chan also announced the launch of the Skills Profiling for SMEs pilot. This is a collaboration between JobKred and SSG, to equip SMEs with the digital tools to better manage the skills development of their workforce. SMEs can use this service to identify skills gaps and follow up on recommended skills training.

A FESTIVAL BY ALL, FOR EVERYONE

SkillsFuture Festival 2023 will comprise physical events in the heart of town and in the heartlands, complemented by a suite of online activities. Enterprises and educators, public agencies and trade associations, unions and professional bodies, will come together to showcase the upskilling opportunities available for Singaporeans, with the aim to engage participants island-wide, and motivate them to take concrete action to progress in their learning journey.

Mr Tan Kok Yam, Chief Executive of SSG, said: “The annual SkillsFuture Festival is a showcase of the progress we have made in lifelong learning. NATIONAL WSH CAMPAIGN 2023

LAUNCH OF THE NATIONAL WSH CAMPAIGN 2023

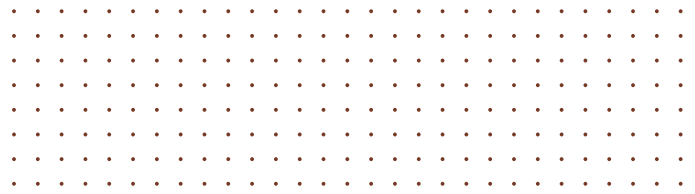
- ◆ The National WSH Campaign 2023 was launched on 23 May 2023, with a strong call to action for individuals, including employers, workers, and members of the public, to play an active role in safeguarding the safety and well-being of workers by reporting unsafe situations in the workplace.
- ◆ National WSH Campaign organized by the Workplace Safety and Health (WSH) Council and supported by the Ministry of Manpower (MOM), the National Trades Union Congress, and the Singapore National Employers Federation, the annual National WSH Campaign serves as a platform for year-long outreach efforts to promote safety and health in workplaces.



- ◆ Mr Abu Bakar Bin Mohd Nor, Chairman of the Workplace Safety and Health Council, delivered a warm welcome address at the launch event. He expressed delight at the collaborative efforts of tripartite partners, including the Ministry of Manpower (MOM), the Singapore National Employers Federation (SNEF), and the National Trades Union Congress (NTUC), in dedicating a year-long focus to workplace safety and health.

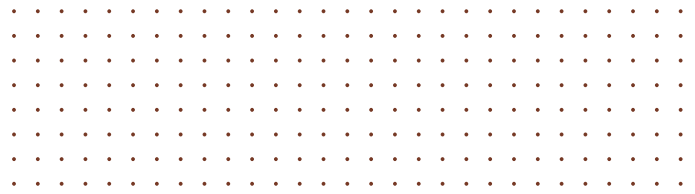


- ◆ During his speech, Mr Abu Bakar emphasized the importance of establishing a work environment where employees feel comfortable speaking up about potential risks and hazards. The campaign's theme, "Reporting Saves Lives," was reiterated as he called on employers, workers, and the public to actively contribute to ensuring the safety and well-being of all individuals.
- ◆ One of the key recommendations from MOM's International Advisory Panel on workplace safety and health was the implementation of internal reporting systems within companies. Employers, particularly small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs), were encouraged to adopt simple and accessible reporting channels. Building a culture of trust between employers and employees, where reporting unsafe situations is viewed as a proactive measure to enhance safety rather than a disruption to work, was highlighted.

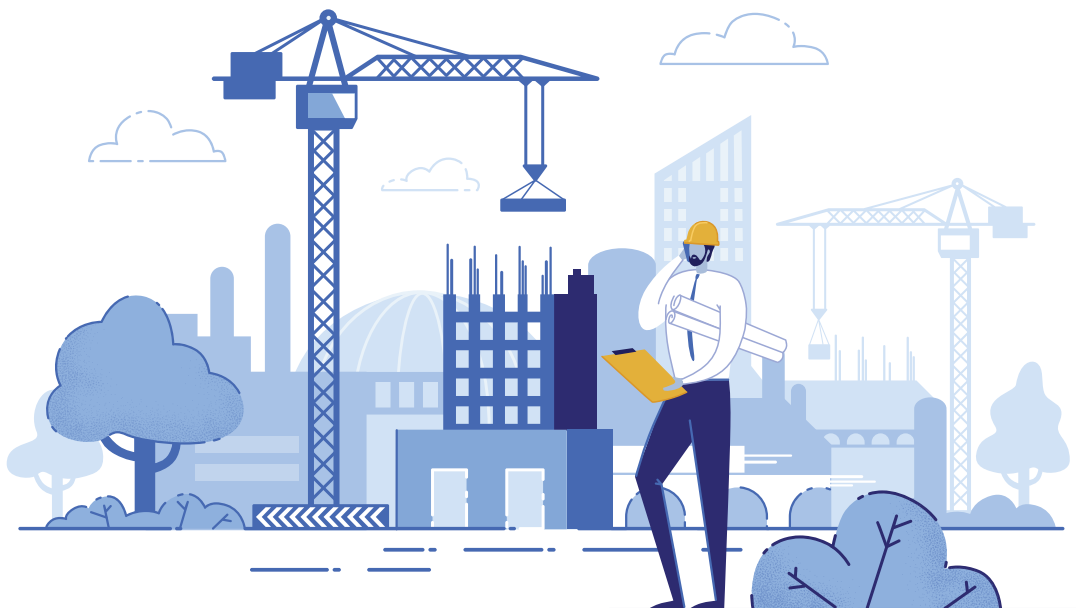


- ◆ SNEF pledged its support in spreading the campaign's message and emphasized the significance of robust internal reporting systems. Workers were also encouraged to speak up and report any unsafe acts or conditions they encountered, assuring them of protection against wrongful dismissal as per the law. NTUC committed to supporting workers by engaging union leaders in addressing safety concerns with management. The campaign also invited members of the public to contribute by reporting unsafe workplace situations.

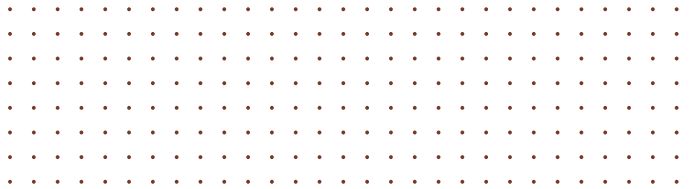

- ◆ Online feedback submission through MOM's SnapSAFE form or scanning QR codes on worksite hoardings provided accessible channels for the public to raise awareness and share information about observed safety lapses. The WSH Council produced collaterals, such as posters, to educate and inform the public about the reporting procedures.
- ◆ ENGIE Services Singapore was highlighted as an exemplary company that embraced the campaign's theme. They developed an Environmental, Health, and Safety (EHS) Portal to facilitate the reporting of unsafe acts and potential risks by employees. Since its implementation, the company has witnessed a significant 58% reduction in incidents observed from January to May 2023 compared to the same period last year. The launch of the National WSH Campaign 2023 served as a powerful reminder of the paramount importance of workplace safety and health. It emphasized the shared responsibility of employers, workers, and the public in creating safer and healthier working environments. The significance of reporting as a means to protect lives and promote well-being resonated strongly throughout the event.
- ◆ This event motivates all stakeholders to actively promote reporting as a means to ensure the safety and well-being of all individuals in the workplace. It reinforces the need for collaboration and the cultivation of a culture where reporting is encouraged, valued, and protected. By working together, we can make significant strides towards creating safer and healthier workplaces for everyone.
