

Written exam duration: 40 mins (Minimum of 40 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) - 20: OFA -10: CPR - 10:AED)

Practical Exam Duration: 20 mins per participant ((Bandaging, CPR+AED & case scenarios) Passing rate for OFA MCQs = 70% Passing rate for CPR + AED MCQs = 80% * If fail in CPR - AED considered as fail in whole examination and need to retake whole course. If fail theory examination or bandaging practical, need only to retake theory exam or bandaging practical.




