Entry Requirement

ESS Workplace literacy and numeracy Level 5 and above.

Participant must have successfully completed the Occupational First Aid Course with CPR+AED (OFAC) and currently holding a valid OFAC certificate.

Does not have any history or underlying medical heart and lung conditions or any physical disabilities/problems such as knee, spinal or joints injury (please consult your doctor to get the necessary clearance to undertake the CPR practice and assessment). Pregnant ladies are highly discouraged from undertaking the CPR practice due to safety reasons.

Course Overview

By the end of the course, the participants will have the relevant knowledge and application skills in demonstrating first aid/CPR skills to apply them in their workplace.

Manage a medical emergency at the workplace.

Manage victims of hazardous chemicals exposure.

Identify common workplace accidents requiring first aid treatment.

Assessment Advice

Written exam duration: 40 mins (Minimum of 40 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) - 20: OFA -10: CPR - 10:AED)

Practical Exam Duration: 20 mins per participant ((Bandaging, CPR+AED & case scenarios)

Passing rate for OFA MCQs = 70% Passing rate for CPR + AED MCQs = 80% * If fail in CPR - AED considered as fail in whole examination and need to retake whole course. If fail theory examination or bandaging practical, need only to retake theory exam or bandaging practical.
