For Whom

The "Apply Workplace Safety and Health in Construction Sites" is a mandatory WSH training course for all workers working in construction sites.

Entry Requirement

Learners are assumed to Possess Employability Skills (ES) Workplace Literacy and Numeracy (WPLN) Level 4 and above, or equivalent.

Legal Requirement

- Have employment status as manual labour to carry out construction work in building and engineering construction worksites & be medically fit & above 18 years.
- Participant must be able to read, write, speak and to manipulate numbers at a proficiency level equivalent to Employability Skills (ES) level 2 (The language in which the course is conducted).
- Students are expected to bring their own safety shoes for the second day of the course.

- To equip all personnel with the relevant safety competencies to work in the Process and related industries;
- To reduce the gestation period before the worker can start working by harmonizing the regulatory requirements with the industry endorsed WSQ training; and

- Activate alarm and evacuate the classroom-practical evacuation drill
