Strengthening Workplace Safety and Health Culture: Insights from the NTUC U Safe Forum & Awards 2024

Introduction:

On January 31, 2024, Senior Minister of State for Manpower, Mr. Zaqy Mohamad, delivered a keynote speech at the NTUC U Safe Forum & Awards 2024 at the Devan Nair Institute for Employment and Employability (E2I), highlighting the importance of collaborative efforts in advancing workplace safety and health (WSH) practices. The event served as a platform to recognize the achievements of organizations committed to fostering a culture of safety and health in the workplace.

Tripartite Collaboration in Strengthening WSH Culture:

Mr. Zaqy Mohamad underscored the significance of tripartite collaboration in enhancing WSH culture, emphasizing the role of the Multi-Agency Workplace Safety and Health Taskforce (MAST) in implementing Safety Accountability, Focus, and Empowerment (SAFE) measures. Through collective input from various stakeholders, including businesses, trade associations, unions, and government agencies, MAST aims to instill a pervasive culture of WSH excellence

Unions' Crucial Role in WSH Advocacy:

Mr. Zaqy Mohamad elaborated on the pivotal role of unions in advocating for worker safety and health.

He emphasized three key areas where unions can actively contribute to improving WSH:

1. Active participation in WSH discussions within companies, leveraging their position as "eyes on the ground" to provide feedback and resolve issues constructively.
2. Support for initiatives such as the "Spot, Stop, and Report" campaign to empower workers to voice concerns and contribute to a culture of trust and openness.
3. Identification and facilitation of WSH training opportunities for union members to enhance safety awareness and competence.



Celebrating WSH Excellence:

The keynote speech celebrated the efforts and achievements of organizations recognized at the U Safe Awards, including unions, unionized companies, and SMEs. The awards commend organizations that champion WSH initiatives, leverage technology for improved outcomes, and promote collective ownership of WSH.

Exemplary Organizations Driving WSH Innovation:

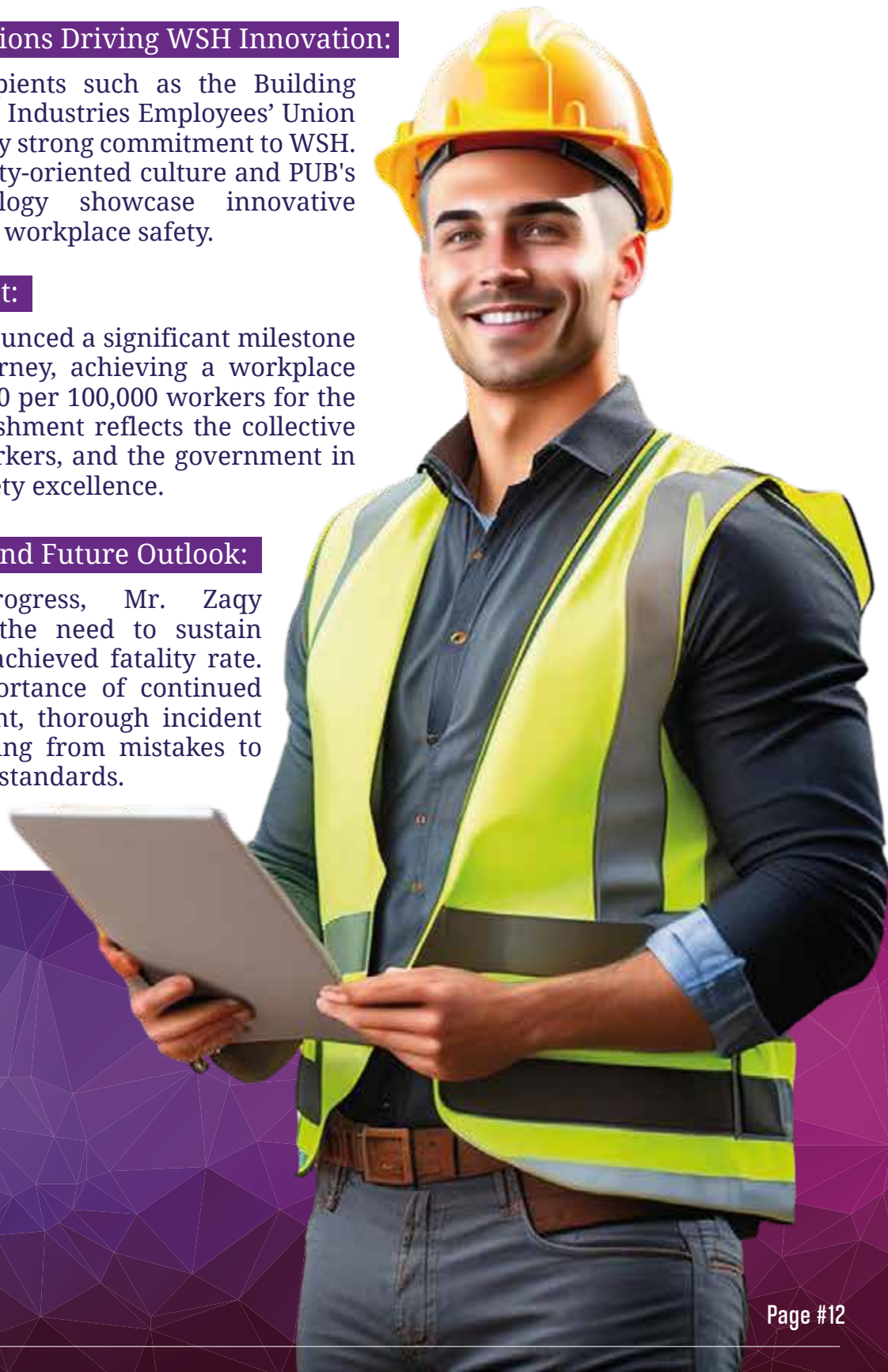
Highlighted award recipients such as the Building Construction and Timber Industries Employees' Union (BATU) and PUB exemplify strong commitment to WSH. BATU's advocacy for safety-oriented culture and PUB's investment in technology showcase innovative approaches to enhancing workplace safety.

National Achievement:

Mr. Zaqy Mohamad announced a significant milestone in Singapore's WSH journey, achieving a workplace fatal injury rate below 1.0 per 100,000 workers for the first time. This accomplishment reflects the collective efforts of employers, workers, and the government in fostering a culture of safety excellence.

Sustaining Progress and Future Outlook:

While celebrating progress, Mr. Zaqy Mohamad emphasized the need to sustain efforts to maintain the achieved fatality rate. He highlighted the importance of continued vigilance, risk assessment, thorough incident investigation, and learning from mistakes to uphold workplace safety standards.





Conclusion:

In closing, Mr. Zaqy Mohamad reiterated the importance of prioritizing workplace safety and health, emphasizing the value of every life in the workforce. As Singapore looks ahead to a prosperous new year, he urged continued commitment to fostering healthy and safe workplaces.

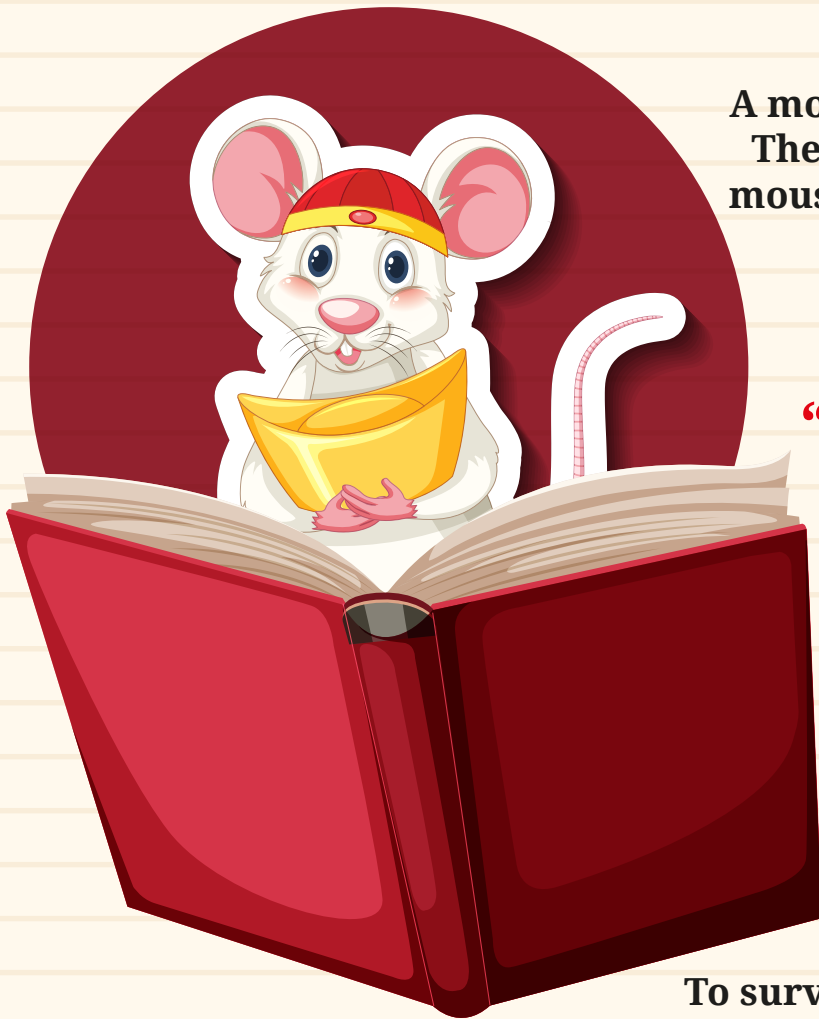

(His life soon ended when the “giving of grains” stopped)

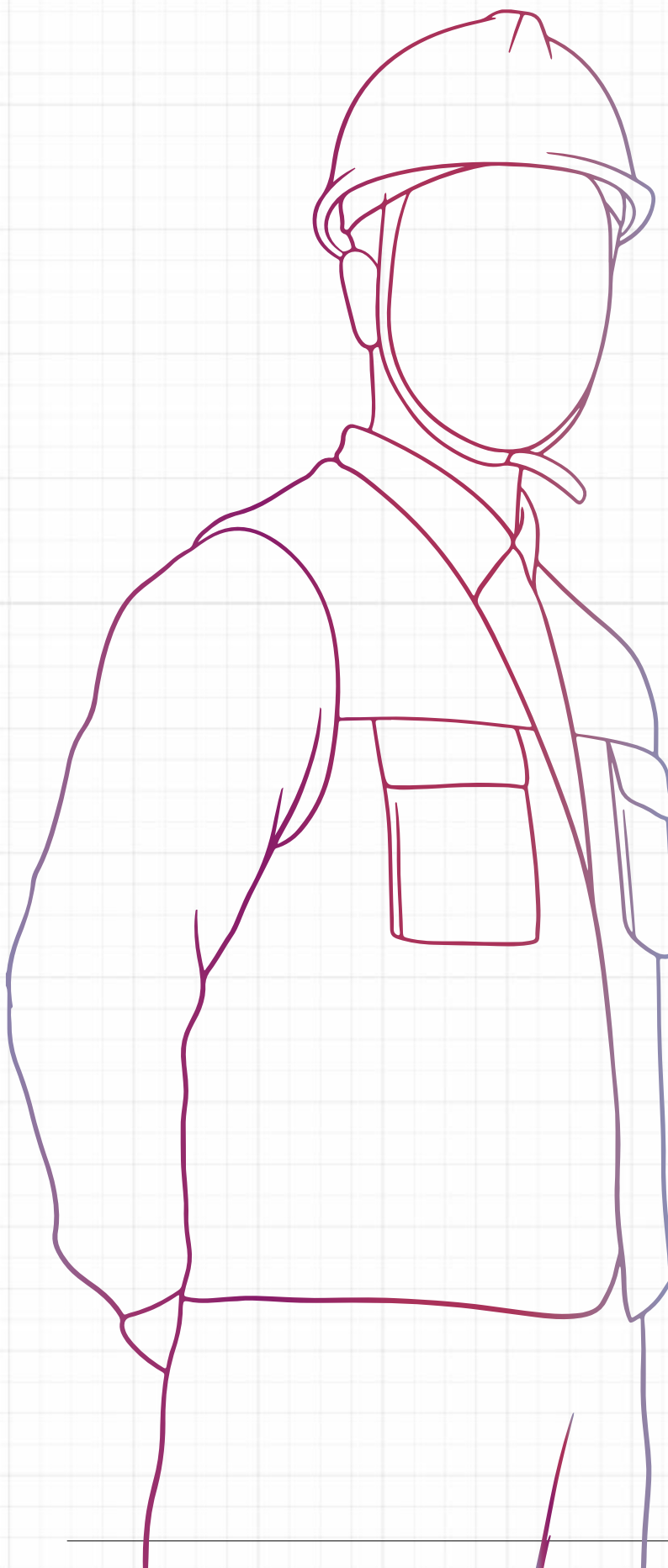
Moral:
