Entry Requirement

This course is designed for all workers carrying out work in a tunnel in building and engineering construction worksite. Workers must have completed and passed ACS/CSOC to be eligible to attend this course.

Legal Requirement

Under the Factories (Safety Training Courses) Order 2001 which came into effect in June 2001, all workers, including Singaporeans, must undergo a Safety Orientation Course (Tunnelling) before they are allowed to work in Tunnels.
