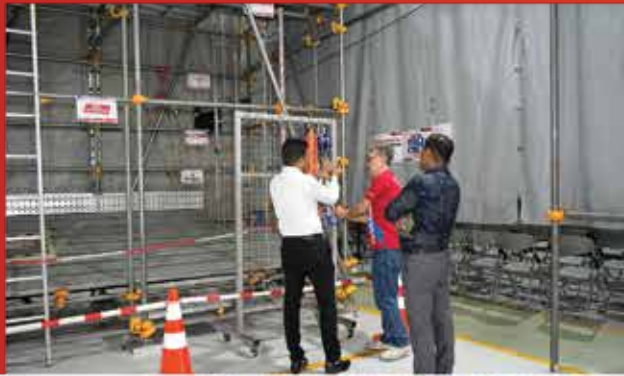

SUMMARY OF THE CODE OF PRACTICE FOR PLATFORM SERVICES

1. SCOPE AND PURPOSE

The Code of Practice (CoP) provides safety and health guidelines for platform operators and workers in ride-hail and delivery services. It strengthens workplace safety responsibilities under the WSH Act and ensures financial protection through Work Injury Compensation Act (WICA) insurance.

Code of Practice for Platform Services



Tripartite Alliance for
Workplace Safety and Health



Platform Operators' Responsibilities:

Protect workers from work-related risks and provide appropriate resources and training.

Platform Workers' Responsibilities:

Follow safety guidelines and take ownership of personal safety and health.

2. General Requirements

Platform Operators should:

- Maintain worker welfare facilities (e.g., rest areas).
- Conduct risk assessments and periodically review them.
- Educate workers on safe usage of equipment and vehicles.
- Ensure workers possess valid licenses and certifications.

Platform Workers should:

- Follow operators' safety guidelines.
- Use personal protective equipment (e.g., helmets) where necessary.
- Report hazards and unsafe practices.

3. Risk Management

A systematic approach to identifying, evaluating, and controlling risks:

Risk Assessment (RA):

Involves hazard identification, risk evaluation, and control measures.

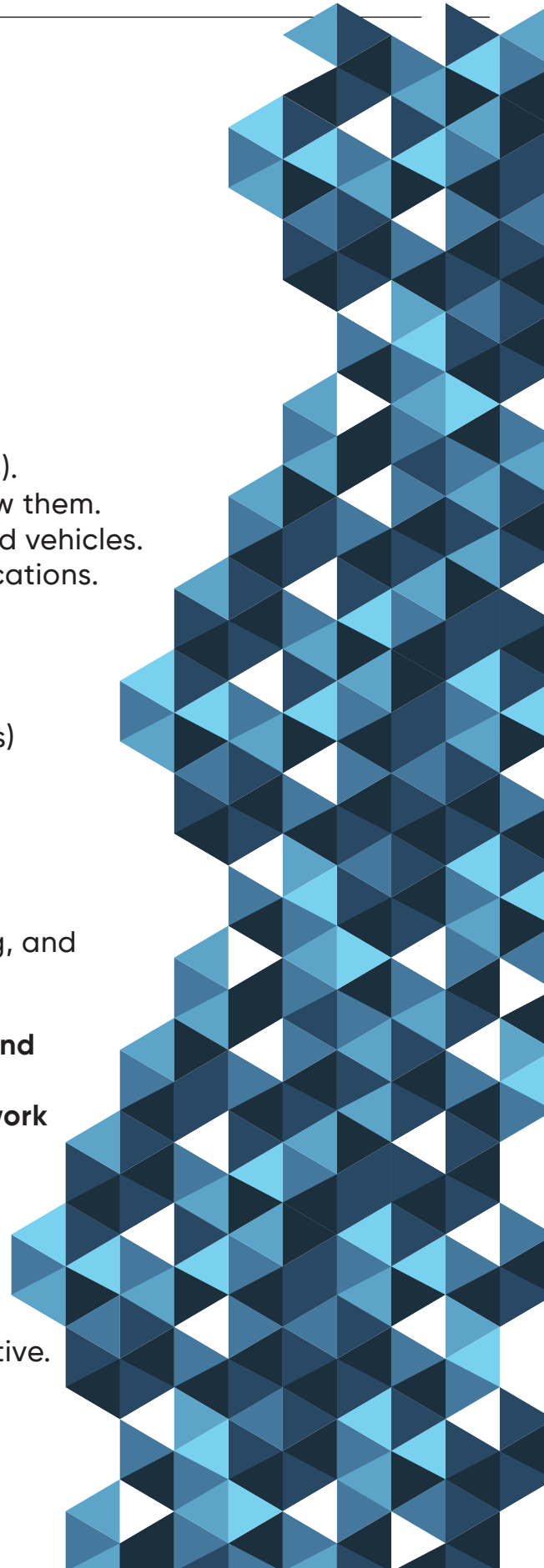
Must include worker involvement and precede work activities.

Risk Control:

- Action plans should detail responsibilities and timelines.
- Inspections and audits ensure controls are effective.

Record Keeping

- Maintain RA documents for three years.



Review:

- Review RAs every three years or after significant changes or incidents.

4. Training and Competency

- Operators must provide orientation, safety training, and refresher courses.
- Workers must maintain valid licenses and report suspensions.

5. Vehicular and Equipment Safety

- Operators ensure all equipment meets safety standards.
- Workers perform daily safety checks and report defects.

6. Road and Traffic Safety

Operators should remind workers to:

- Follow traffic rules and regulations.
- Avoid unsafe practices (e.g., using phones while riding).
- Wear reflective clothing for visibility.

7. General Safety Measures

Fatigue Management:

- Operators remind workers to take breaks.
- Workers rest in safe locations during shifts.

Heat Stress Management:

- Operators educate workers about heat-related illnesses and encourage hydration.
- Workers monitor heat conditions using tools like the myENV app.



8. Emergency Response

- Operators must establish clear emergency plans, including reporting procedures and contact points for assistance.
- Workers should document accidents, report incidents to operators, and seek medical attention promptly.



Conclusion:

The CoP emphasizes a collaborative effort to enhance safety and health outcomes. Operators are encouraged to adopt effective measures while workers are expected to uphold personal responsibility for safety.

ChatGPT Essentials for Safety Professionals: A Continuing Professional Development Perspective.

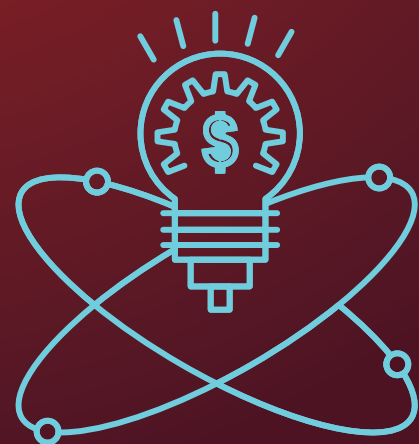
