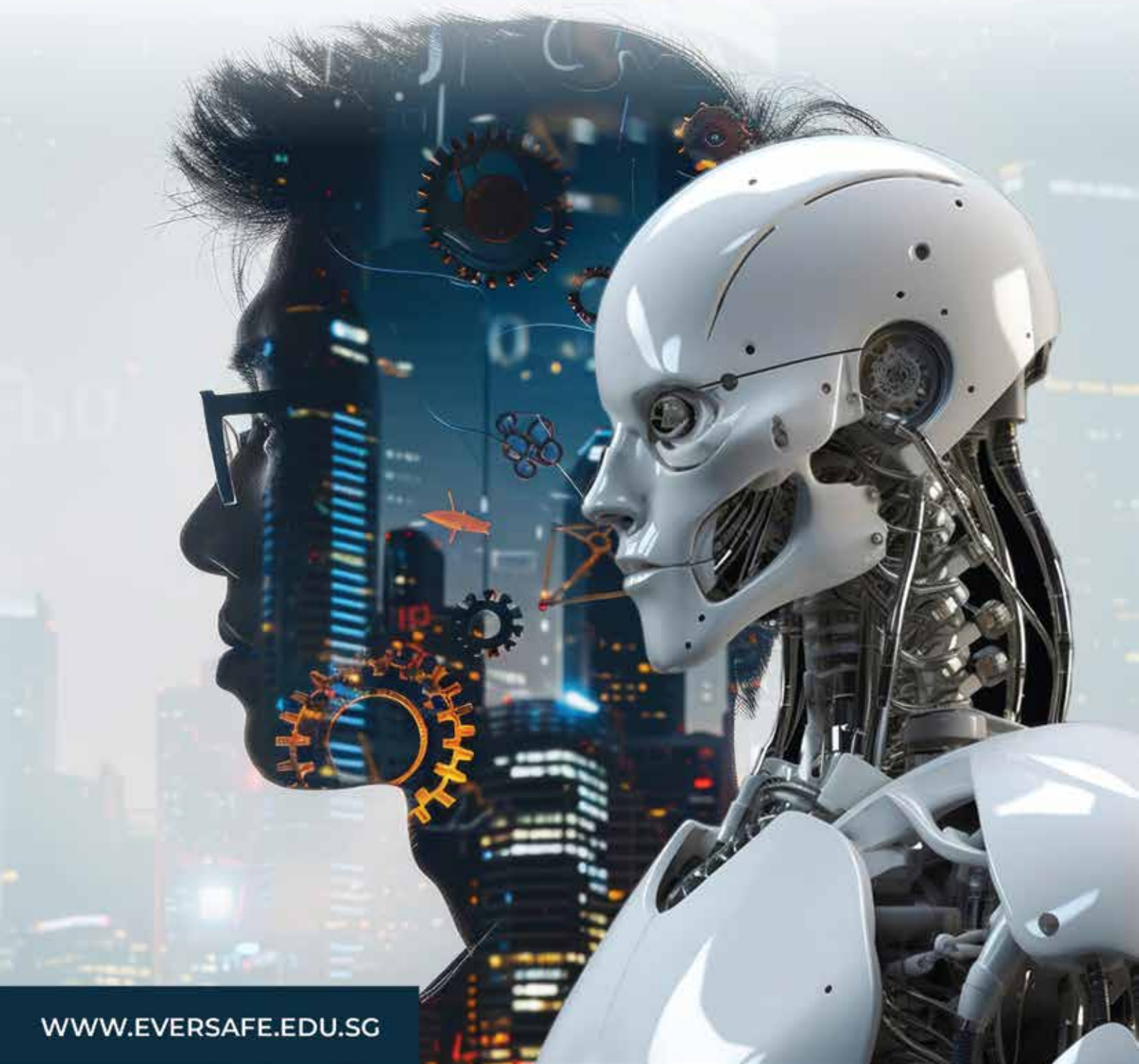

Enhanced Safety Measures for Higher-Risk Machinery and Combustible Dust

Introduction:

From 1 January 2025, companies must comply with updated regulations to strengthen workplace safety and health (WSH) standards for higher-risk machinery and combustible dust. These new measures aim to address safety concerns related to the use of complex industrial machinery and the potential hazards of combustible dust, ensuring a safer working environment across industries.

Safe Use of Machinery:

The Fifth Schedule of the WSH Act will be expanded to include several categories of machinery considered higher-risk, such as:

- Sheet Benders and Sheet Rollers
- Lathes and Milling Machines
- Machines designed for industrial use for:
 - Cutting (e.g., table saws, slicing machines)
 - Packaging (e.g., palletisers, balers, compactors)
 - Mixing by mechanical movement (e.g., paddle mixers, ribbon mixers)
 - Handling or processing food (e.g., grinders, mincers, blenders, juicers)
- Under this expansion, Section 16 and 17 duties of the WSH Act will now apply to manufacturers, suppliers, installers, and modifiers of these machines.

Manufacturer and Supplier Responsibilities:

- ◆ **Safety Assurance:** Manufacturers must ensure that machinery is designed, tested, and safe when used correctly.
- ◆ **Safety Information:** Manufacturers are required to provide comprehensive guidelines and safety instructions for proper machine use.
- ◆ **Installer and Modifier Responsibilities:** Safe Installation and Modification: Installers and modifiers must ensure that machinery installation or modification does not compromise safety features. These steps will reassure buyers that the machinery they purchase meets established safety standards and is compliant with regulatory requirements.

Safe Use of Combustible Dust

Combustible Dust refers to fine, combustible particles that can form a flash fire or explosion hazard when suspended in the air. The Fourth Schedule of the WSH (General Provisions) Regulations includes a list of combustible dust types. As of 1 January 2025, combustible dust will be added to the Fifth Schedule of the WSH Act, broadening the scope of manufacturer and supplier duties to include this critical hazard.

Labelling of Combustible Dust

In workplaces where combustible dust is handled, containers and packages must be labelled with:

- ◆ **Hazard Warning:** The label must explicitly state, "Warning: May form explosible dust-air mixture if dispersed."
- ◆ **Precautionary Measures:** Information on how to handle combustible dust safely. For organic combustible dusts like flour, sugar, or potato starch, labelling will only be required for packages of 25kg or more.

Notification on Use of Combustible Dust

Factories that handle, store, process, manufacture, or use combustible dust at or above the prescribed threshold quantity must notify:

Ministry of Manpower (MOM):

At least one month before starting or increasing the use of combustible dust above the threshold quantity.

Within one month after stopping its use.

Building Owner/Landlord:

Before starting or stopping the use of combustible dust at or above the threshold, ensuring that landlords are informed and can take appropriate actions to manage risks among tenants.

This notification process provides MOM with oversight on factories handling combustible dust and enables building owners to avoid conflicts between incompatible uses of space.

Conclusion

The introduction of these new safety measures for higher-risk machinery and combustible dust reflects a significant step forward in improving workplace safety standards. These updates require manufacturers, suppliers, installers, and users to actively engage in maintaining a safe work environment by ensuring that machinery meets safety standards and by properly managing hazardous substances like combustible dust. Compliance with these updated regulations will help prevent accidents and ensure the overall safety of workers in industries dealing with high-risk machinery and materials.

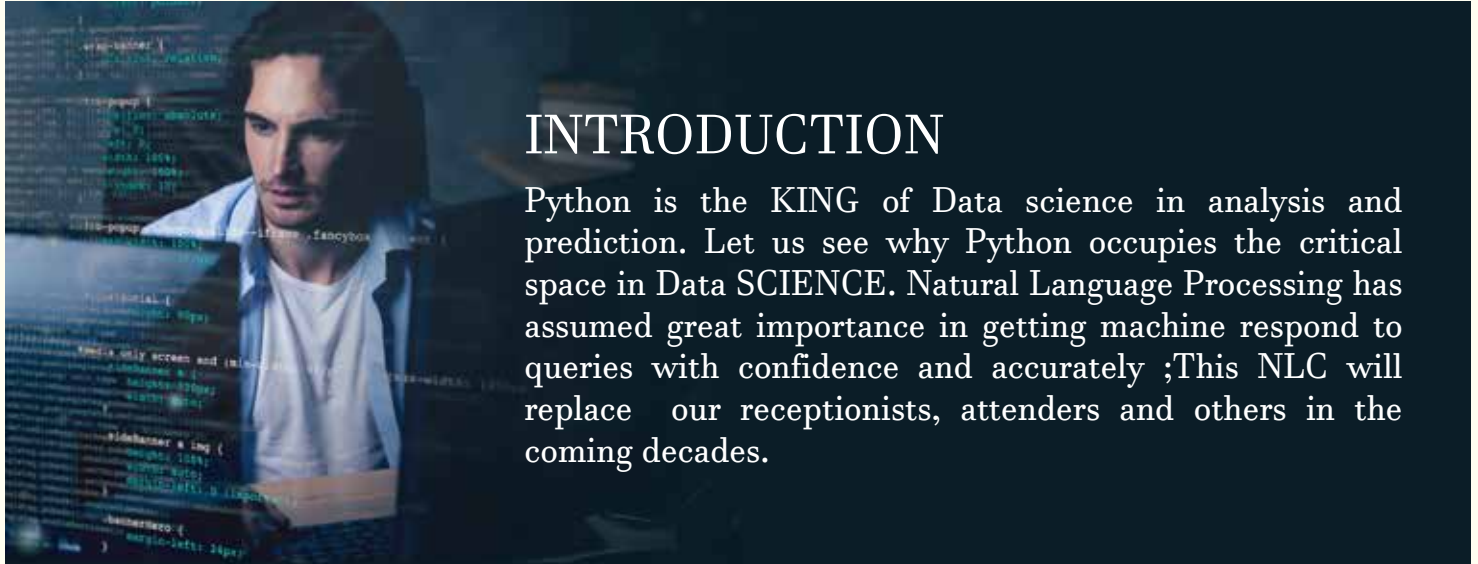

2. Why Choose Python for Data Science & Machine Learning

Many data scientists and machine learning practitioners may have chosen Python because the code they wrote can be integrated into a live and dynamic web application.

Although it's all debatable, Python is still a popular choice especially among beginners or anyone who wants to get their feet wet fast with data analysis and machine learning. It's relatively easy to learn and you can dive into full time programming later on if you decide this suits you more.

Widespread Use of Python in Data Analysis

There are now many packages and tools that make the use of Python in data analysis and machine learning much easier. TensorFlow from Google, Theano, scikit-learn, numpy, and pandas are just some of the things that make data science faster and easier.

NLP is very useful in these areas due to the massive availability of data from online activities. Remember that we can vastly improve our data analysis and machine learning model if we have sufficient amounts of quality data to work on.

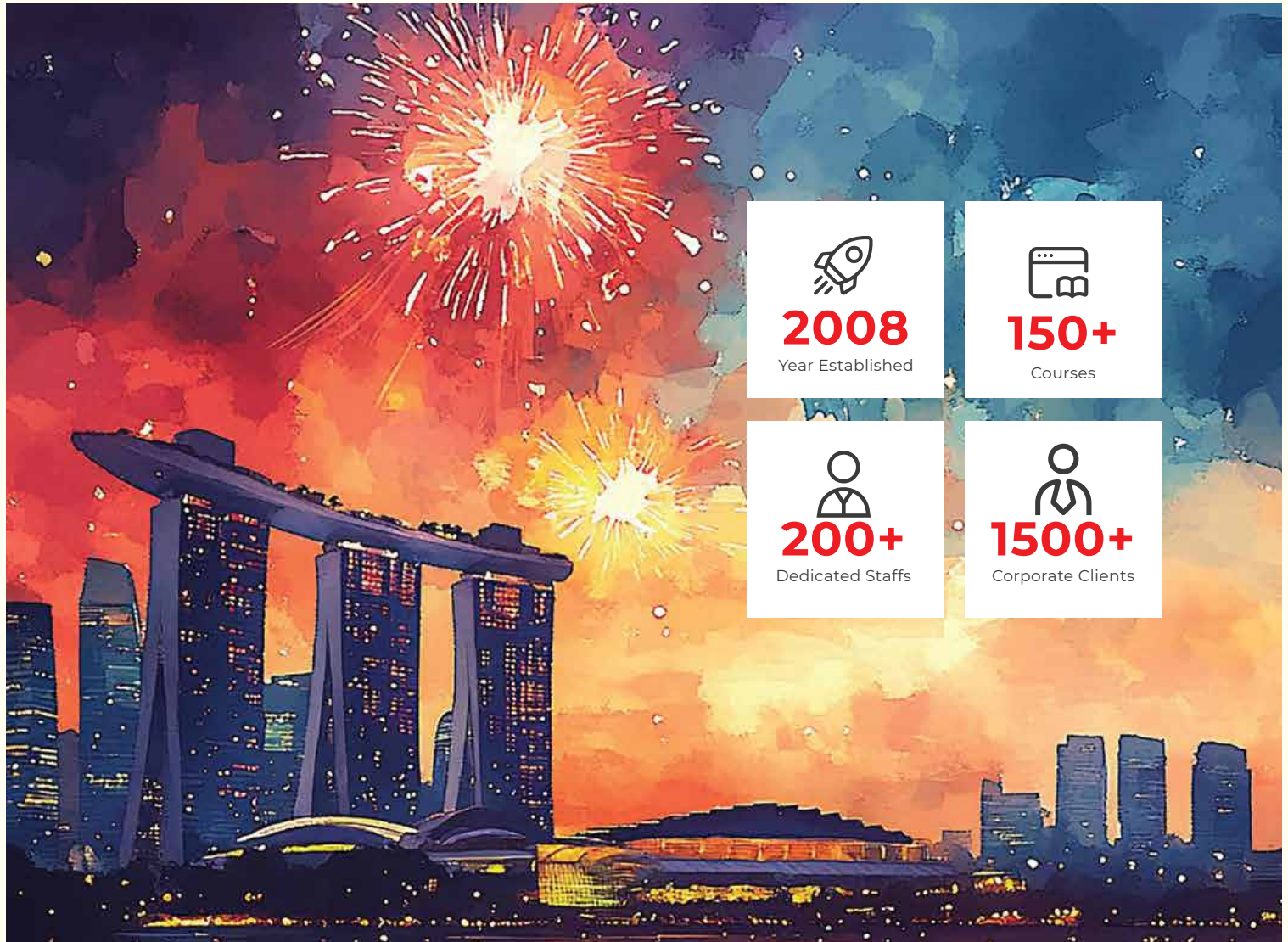
