For Whom

- **Suspended Scaffold (Gondola) Operator Course (SSOC)** is for individuals who are required to operate suspended scaffolds (Gondola) safely in the workplace, including workers, supervisors, and other personnel involved in Suspended scaffold operations.

Entry Requirement

- Minimum age of 18 years.
- Medically fit to work at height and perform physical tasks.
- Ability to read and write in English.
- Ability to read and understand manufacturer's instructions, procedures, and safety signs.
- Good situational awareness and safety consciousness.
- Valid certification in one of the following: Perform Work at Height (PWAH), Apply Workplace Safety and Health in Construction Sites (AWCHCS) Manage Work at Height (MWAH), or Construction Safety Orientation Course (CSOC).

Course Duration

- 8 Hours including 30 Mins of Written assessment and 2 Hours 30 Mins of Practical Performance
