Enhancing Vehicular Safety Standards - Incorporating speed limiter checks into Risk Management (RM) Implementation Audit Checklist

New bizSAFE Audit Requirements for Speed Limiters

As we progress into 2026, the Workplace Safety and Health (WSH) Council has introduced critical updates to the Risk Management (RM) Implementation Audit Checklist. Effective January 1, 2026, there is an enhanced focus on vehicular safety, specifically regarding the mandatory installation of speed limiters on lorries.

Background and Necessity

Work-related traffic accidents (WRTA) consistently account for approximately 10% of annual workplace fatalities in Singapore. Recent data highlights a fluctuating but persistent trend in fatalities:

- 1H 2024: 19 fatal injuries, with 3 resulting from WRTA.
- 2H 2024: 24 fatal injuries, with 1 resulting from WRTA.
- 1H 2025: 17 fatal injuries, with 3 resulting from WRTA.

Speeding remains a significant factor in these incidents, putting drivers, passengers, and road users at high risk of injury. To address this, the bizSAFE RM Implementation Audit now enforces speed limiter checks as a mandatory requirement for all companies owning lorries.



Mandatory Compliance and Vehicle Scope

The new audit requirement is broad and applies to every company that owns lorries, regardless of the specific industry (e.g., logistics, construction, or manufacturing).

Industry News & Trends

Types of Vehicles Covered Auditors must verify that speed limiters are installed on all types of lorries, including:

- Goods Lorries and G-plate lorries.
- Lorry Cranes.
- Lorries with exposed trailer beds.
- Lorries fitted with canopies and rain covers.



Critical Clarifications

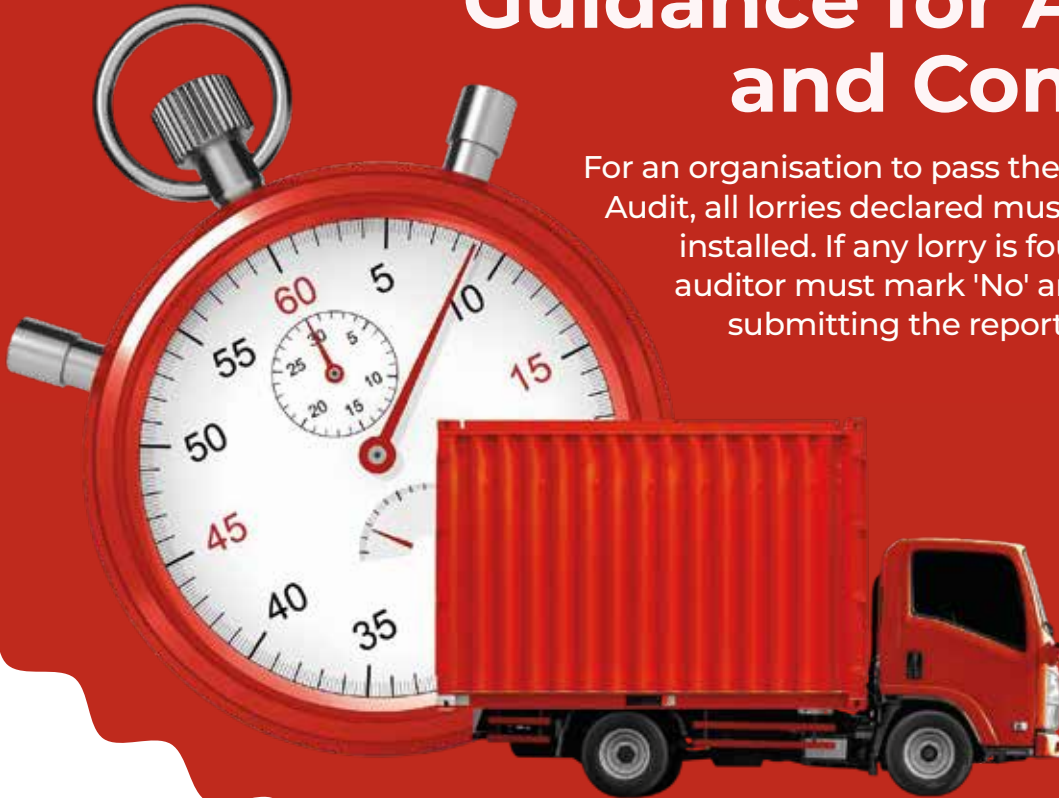
The new audit requirement is broad and applies to every company that owns lorries, regardless of the specific industry (*e.g., logistics, construction, or manufacturing*).

- **All Weights Included:** Unlike some Traffic Police requirements that may specify weight ranges, this WSH Council requirement applies to all lorries regardless of Maximum Laden Weight (MLW).
- **Vans Excluded:** Company vans are excluded from the speed limiter requirement, though they are still assessed under general vehicular safety practices.
- **Rental Lorries:** Companies renting lorries are considered the "owners" during the rental period and must ensure their rented fleet is compliant.
- **Speed Warning Devices (SWDs):** SWDs are not sufficient for audit compliance, as they only alert the driver rather than physically limiting the vehicle's maximum speed.

Industry News & Trends

Guidance for Auditors and Companies

For an organisation to pass the RM Implementation Audit, all lorries declared must have speed limiters installed. If any lorry is found without one, the auditor must mark 'No' and is prohibited from submitting the report to the WSH Council.



Audit Guidance and Evidence Requirements

To support the transition toward vehicular safety, the Safe Management Measures (SMM) audit highlight has been removed from the RM Audit checklist as of January 1, 2026.

Industry News & Trends

Necessary Supporting Evidence

Auditors are required to verify implementation through:

1. Document Review (DR): Official invoices from authorized installation agents or annual vehicle inspection reports (e.g., from VICOM).
2. Physical Inspection (PI): Random spot checks on lorries on-site to verify the official speed limiter label is pasted on the windscreen.
3. Personnel Interviews (IP): Evaluating if remuneration practices, such as pay-per-trip, negatively impact safety behaviors.

Conclusion and Regulatory Alignment

The mandatory requirements for the bizSAFE RM Implementation Audit are distinctly separate from Traffic Police (TP) timelines. Even if TP requirements for a specific vehicle model allow for later installation, companies undergoing a bizSAFE audit must have speed limiters installed by the date of the audit to achieve a "Yes" result.

By incorporating these checks, the industry moves closer to the goal of "Take Time to Take Care" for every worker's safety and health.

DIGITAL SAFETY COACHES ARE HERE

AI ASSISTANTS GUIDING WORKERS IN REAL TIME



Factories, construction sites, and warehouses have always relied on human vigilance to prevent accidents. Hard hats, training manuals, and supervisors form the traditional defense line. Yet humans are famously imperfect biological machines—we forget steps, miss hazards, or get distracted for a moment. In safety-critical environments, a single distracted second can cause injury.

A new technological ally is stepping onto the worksite: digital safety coaches powered by artificial intelligence. These AI assistants monitor environments, guide workers, and warn them about risks in real time, dramatically reducing human error.

Think of them as invisible safety trainers standing beside every worker, every minute of the shift.

WHAT IS A DIGITAL SAFETY COACH?

A digital safety coach is an AI-driven system that observes workplace conditions and provides instant guidance to workers. These systems combine technologies such as:

- Computer vision cameras
- Wearable sensors and smart helmets
- Augmented reality (AR) glasses
- AI assistants and safety chatbots

Together, they analyze the environment and worker behavior continuously. When a risk appears—missing protective equipment, unsafe posture, proximity to machinery—the system immediately alerts the worker or supervisor.

HOW AI GUIDES WORKERS IN REAL TIME

Imagine a worker entering a high-risk zone in a manufacturing plant. A traditional safety system might rely on periodic inspections or manual reporting. But an AI safety assistant works differently:

- 1. Environmental Monitoring**
Cameras and sensors scan the workspace to identify hazards such as spills, unsafe zones, or exposed machinery.
- 2. Behavior Recognition**
Computer vision analyzes worker movements to detect unsafe actions—like improper lifting posture or missing PPE.
- 3. Instant Feedback**
If a worker enters a restricted area without a helmet, the system immediately sends a warning to their wearable device or supervisor.
- 4. Continuous Learning**
AI systems learn from past incidents and patterns to predict potential risks

THE HUMAN-AI PARTNERSHIP

Despite the futuristic technology, digital safety coaches are not replacing safety professionals.

They enhance them.

Humans still provide judgment, experience, and ethical oversight. AI simply expands human awareness—like giving every safety officer thousands of extra eyes and ears across the entire facility.

The result is a powerful collaboration:

- Humans provide expertise and decision-making.
- AI provides constant monitoring and instant alerts.

Together, they create safer workplaces.

THE FUTURE OF WORKPLACE SAFETY

As Industry 5.0 evolves, workplaces will become increasingly connected and intelligent. Safety systems will integrate AI, robotics, sensors, and immersive training tools.

Future worksites may include:

- Smart helmets with voice-activated safety assistants
- AI cameras that automatically document safety incidents
- Predictive systems that forecast accidents before they happen
- Digital twins that simulate hazards in real time

Safety will shift from compliance-based supervision to continuous, intelligent guidance.

And in that world, every worker will have something previous generations never had: A digital safety coach quietly watching out for them.

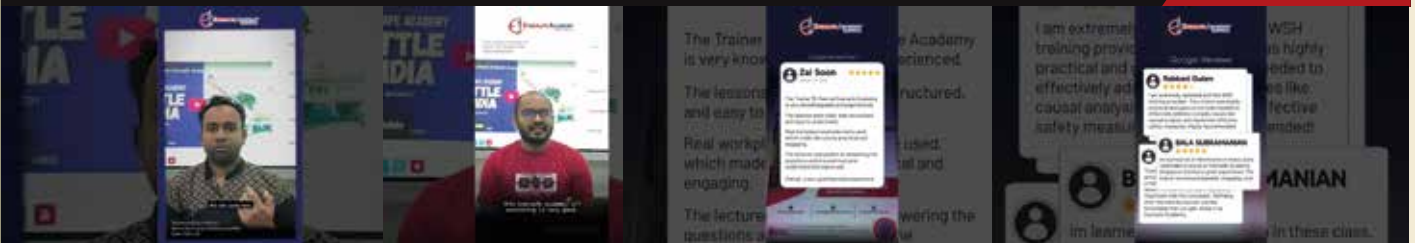
