Target Audience

This workshop is designed for MOM registered crane operators to raise their safety competencies in the operation of cranes e.g. Crawler Crane, Dockside Tower Crane, Mobile Crane (Truck Mounted), Tower Crane (Luffing Jib) and Tower Crane (Saddle Jib).

Entry Requirement

- MOM-registered crane operator with a valid license or expired under 6 months
- Examination Criteria for WESCO written test:
 - To be exempt from the WESCO written test, please provide your old WESCO certificate.

Exam Requirements

If your registration has expired, you may need to pass a test or attend a course before renewing:

If your licence has expired for	You need to
Less than 6 months	Proceed to renew.
6 months to less than 3 years	Pass the test conducted by an accredited training provider.
3 years to less than 5 years	Attend a refresher course and pass the test conducted by an accredited training provider.
5 years or more	Attend the full course and pass the test conducted by an accredited training provider.

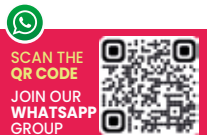
